


The purpose of the proposed project is to improve safety and mobility to accommodate for future traffic volumes.






#### The proposed FM 1378 project includes:

- Widening the existing 2-lane roadway to a 4-lane roadway.
- A grassy median to separate the eastbound and westbound lanes.
- Drainage improvements within the project limits.
- Intersection improvements with turn lanes.
- The proposed right of way width would vary from 125 feet to 180 feet.

#### **Environmental Review – Right of Way**




#### **Proposed Right-of-Way**

- Approximately 7.6 acres of new right of way would be required for the proposed project.
- Potential displacements include four residences and one non-residential structure.
- All right-of-way acquisition would be completed in accordance with the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970, as amended.
