Project Purpose:


The purpose of the proposed project is to improve safety and mobility to accommodate for future traffic volumes.

The proposed project is needed to improve safety and meet future travel demands from projected population growth and traffic volumes.



Existing Roadway Typical Section






Project Details & Proposed Typical Section

The proposed FM 1378 project includes:

- Widening the existing 2-lane roadway to a 4-lane
 roadway.
- A curbed median to separate the eastbound and westbound lanes.
- Drainage improvements within the project limits.
- Intersection improvements with turn lanes.
- The proposed typical right-of-way width would vary from 130-feet to 140-feet.





Projected Construction Cost and Schedule

Environmental Review

Traffic Noise

 A Traffic Noise Analysis was accomplished in accordance with TxDOT's (and FHWA approved) Guidelines for Analysis and Abatement of Roadway Traffic Noise. Based on the analysis, noise barriers were determined to be not reasonable and feasible; therefore none are proposed for incorporation into the proposed project.

Cultural Resources

 13 historic-age properties were studied and recommended as not eligible for the National Register of Historic Places.

Water Resources

- No construction within a floodplain or wetland.
- One intermittent stream would be covered with a U.S. Army Corps of Engineers nonreporting Nationwide Permit 14.



Environmental Review - Right-of-Way

The proposed project would require 6.7 acres of additional right of way

Potential displacements include three residences and two non-residential structures. Information on the right-of-way acquisition process is available at txdot.gov and on the Virtual Public Hearing webpage:

- Landowner's Bill of Rights
- Relocation Assistance
- State Purchase of Right-of-Way

Acquisition and relocation assistance would be in accordance with the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Properties Acquisitions Policies Act of 1970, as amended.
